




Thank you for the classes and making them available.




# You Make Dreams Come True

Ana had a years-long dream of adopting a child. After just one informational session with DePelchin, she had all the encouragement and support she needed to begin the journey.

Ana grew up in Spain as one of five siblings and had a cousin who was adopted. After settling in Texas, she mentioned to her friends that she dreamt of adoption herself, though she worried that being single could get in the way.

But thanks to support from friends like you, Ana was trained and licensed to be a foster parent through DePelchin.



After initially caring for three children in foster care on a short-term basis, Ana joyfully welcomed her fourth child through foster care.



"Everything was really smooth,"
Ana says. "I don't remember
having any issues at all. Any
questions I had were just because
it was a new situation, and
DePelchin answered them all."

Ana welcomed a four-monthold baby to her home, and she quickly came to love him "like a mom." She admits she was initially nervous because the baby was a temporary placement. But two years later, paperwork was finalized to officially adopt Raphael as her son. "It was a dream come true," Ana says.

From the start, Ana says DePelchin has been a strong support to her and Rafael, helping her access occupational and developmental therapy for Rafael, diapers and so much more.

"I would like to thank you from the bottom of my heart," she says to donors like you. "I can't believe how generous people are. What you are doing is great because you are really helping the kids, and my kid."

### You Walk Alongside Families in Transition

Cecilia and Jay's journey to adoption was full of ups and downs, which is why they're especially grateful for your support every step of the way.

Cecilia says she dreamt of adoption for as long as she can remember — something she shared early in her relationship with husband, Jay. The couple met and married in their 30s and began pursuing adoption through DePelchin several years later.

"I am now in my 40s," Cecilia says, noting she feels, "I'm way too old to be getting up every two hours to feed a baby."

With that in mind, and the substantial need for adults willing to parent older children and teenagers, the couple requested an older child through DePelchin's foster to adopt program. They soon welcomed Chris, 13, home. This past April, adoption was finalized for Chris, now 14.

Cecilia says, "It was an emotional roller-coaster for a whole year.

Our case manager was our saving grace. Everybody that we've worked with at DePelchin has been phenomenal and we would

definitely recommend them to other people"


